Virginia Treasury Makes it Easier To Find Your Unclaimed Property!

Virginia Department of the Treasury Unclaimed Property Program is a <u>free public service</u> that reunites rightful owners with their dormant/inactive accounts that have been escheated or reported to The Commonwealth of Virginia.





Using your smartphone, open your camera and scan above QR code. This will take you to our Virginia Treasury's Unclaimed Property Program free search site, www.vamoneysearch.gov.



On this free search site scroll down to "Claiming Property" and type your first and last name, deceased loved one or business name and click the search button.



If you have potential unclaimed property in our system that may belong to you, a result list will populate. Now click the orange "claim" button on any property that may belong to you by confirming your first & last name, the cities you've lived in and your account holders.



Once you've clicked "claim" on all of the possible properties, click "continue to file claim". Select your relationship to each property on your claim and click "file claim".



Complete instructions to enter your information (CHOOSE OUTREACH EVENT for how you heard about this service). Electronically sign and submit your claim. You will now see a green confirmation box.



You may receive an email with instructions if you need to **upload evidence** to our secure portal.



Once we receive what is needed, your claim will be processed and you will be able to check your claim status on our website.
